

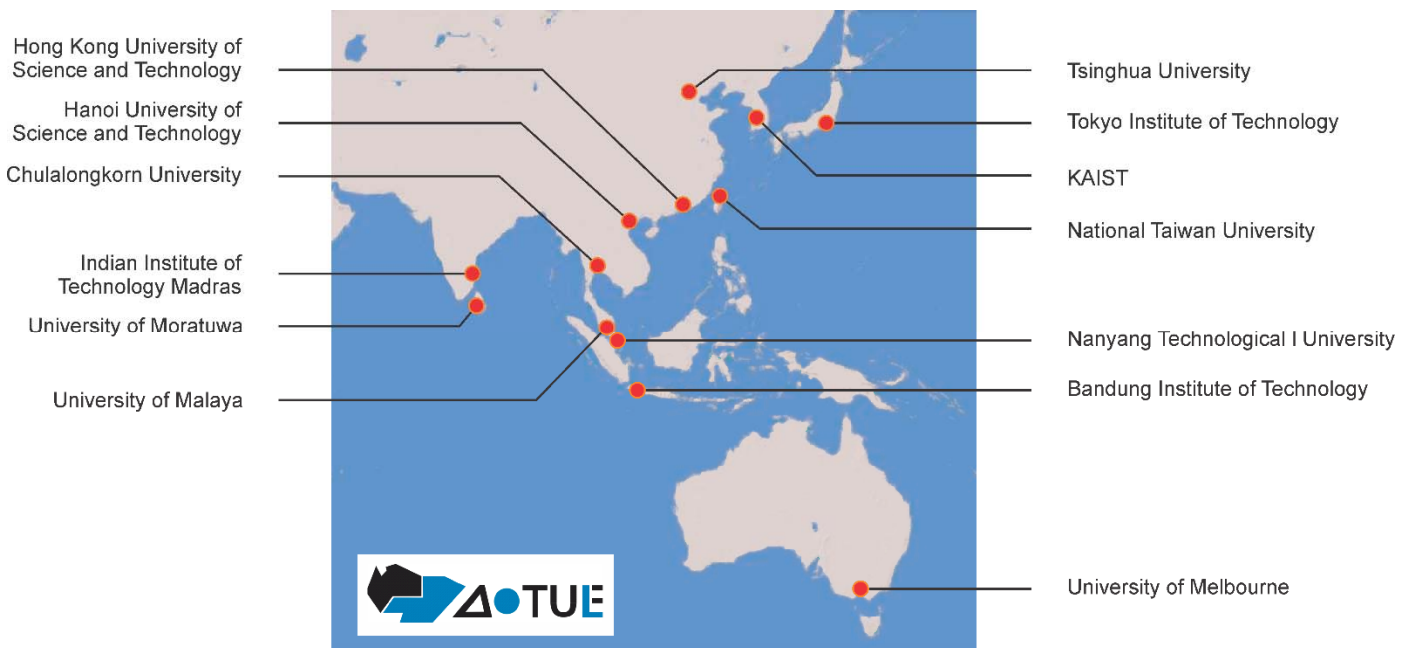


## AOTULE – Leading Engineering Schools in the Asia-Oceania Region
